When Pastor Derek Worthington baptized a local lifeguard on the shores of Nantucket Island, it marked more than just a spontaneous decision for Christ. It symbolized a church finding its way back to its mission. Four years earlier, Summer Street Church had entered a challenging season of pastoral transition and post-pandemic fatigue.
